Exciting Employment Opportunities with River Region Human Services EOE/DFWP

Counselor - Children's Treatment (FT) 6647

The Children's Treatment Counselor assesses client needs and conducts group therapy sessions with their assigned unit. Must monitor client behavior, facilitate referrals to community resources, and document all cases properly. A Bachelor's degree in the behavioral health field with two years substance abuse treatment experience is preferred. Must be knowledgeable of 65D-30 standards with the ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing. Computer competency required. A valid Florida driver's license and a good driving record are required.

LPN -Methadone (FT) 6969

The LPN dispenses medication, and keeps accurate records of dosages administered to clients as scheduled. Must communicate client information to doctors, counselors, and administration as needed. Must be a valid Florida State Practical Nurse with at least two years of relevant experience. Computer competency required. Must be able to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.

Monitor Technician - Residential (FT) 7260, 7262

The Monitor Technician is responsible for logging daily client activities and monitoring their behavior. A high school diploma or GED is required with two years of relevant experience. Must be available to work weekend and night shifts. A valid Florida driver's license and a good driving record are required. Must be able to provide own transportation. Computer competency required. Must be able to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.

Co-Occurring Counselor-Children's Treatment (FT) 7171

The Co-Occurring Counselor must provide 25 hours each week of client contact hours and individual counseling to assigned caseload in accordance with agency and licensing requirements. Must ensure that individualized treatment is designed for each client and conduct assessments as scheduled each week for review within 24 hours. Licensed preferred or Master's degree in the behavioral health field with two years substance abuse treatment and mental health experience. A valid Florida driver's license and a good driving record are required. Computer competency required.

Counselor/Driver - Intervention (FT) 7275

The Counselor/Driver performs individual sessions, groups and interventions, coordinates individualized development of treatment plans, conducts group counseling sessions, communicates with Juvenile Drug Court Case Managers, and transports clients to and from group, court, and other locations as directed. A Bachelor's Degree in a behavioral health or human service with at least two years of relevant experience is required. Experience in a social service environment is preferred. Computer competency, a valid Florida driver's license and a good driving record are required. Must be able to provide own transportation. Must be able to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.

Staff Aide - ALF (PRN) 7331

The Staff Aide documents actions and incidents, provides crisis intervention and monitors clients' behavior. A high school diploma or GED with at least two years of relevant experience is required. A valid Florida driver's license and a good driving record are required. Must be able to provide own transportation. Computer competency required. Must be able to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.

Education Specialist – Corrections (FT) 7350

The Education Specialist conducts substance abuse/dependency and related issues classes within the Duval County Jail system, completes substance abuse/dependency screenings for potential admissions into the Corrections Therapeutic Community, and provides referral and program/services information. A high school diploma or GED with at least two years of relevant experience is required. Acceptable professional certification as an addictions and/or criminal justice professional and experience in a social service environment is preferred. Must be able to communicate effectively verbally and in writing, have a valid Florida driver's license, a good driving record, and be able to provide own transportation. Computer competency required.

Group Facilitator - Outreach (FT) 7404

The Group Facilitator oversees the development, planning, implementation, and evaluation for group intervention programs. High school diploma or GED required. Computer competency required. A valid Florida driver's license and a good driving record are required. Must be able to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.

Psychosocial Rehabilitation Specialist- Mental Health (FT) 7405

The Psychosocial Rehabilitation Specialist develops comprehensive individualized treatment plans with clients to meet their treatment goals. A Bachelor's degree with at least two years of related experience is required. A valid Florida driver's license and a good driving record are required. Must be able to provide own transportation. Computer competency required. Must be able to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.

Peer Social Media Specialist- Service Support (FT) 7443, 7444

The Peer Social Media Specialist is responsible for mentoring and coaching consumers in self-empowerment, self-advocacy stigma-busting skills. Must consult with program staff, Deppe Communications and members of the target population, conduct online and onsite outreach, social media sourcing and usage, development and deployment of substance abuse and HIV/AIDS prevention and intervention messages. High School diploma or GED, skills in using social media and experience in behavioral health services is required. Membership in, cultural knowledge of and social familiarity with target population are required.

Peer Coordinator- Service Support (FT) 7445

Must provide supervision and coordination of NM2 services and activities. Must collaborate and coordinate with Deppe Communications and other community partners. Must actively combat negative stereotypes, stigma, discrimination, social/cultural exclusion. High School diploma or GED, higher education preferred. At least 2 years of personal behavioral health and at least 2 years of experience in behavioral health, HIV/AIDS and substance abuse education and prevention services. A valid Florida driver's license and a good driving record are required. Must be able to provide own transportation.

Maintenance Assistant - Support Services (FT) 7447

The Maintenance Assistant assists with maintaining structures owned, rented or leased by the agency, constructs and remodels items according to local building codes and supervisory directions, conducts quarterly inspections, performs preventive maintenance, and maintains and stores equipment, tools, and supplies. Must have at least 6 years of maintenance experience and be able to provide own transportation. A high school diploma or GED. A valid driver's license and a good driving record are required. Must be able to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.

Counselor Assistant- Corrections (FT) 7448

The Counselor Assistant completes a thorough assessment and intake of each new admission into the Therapeutic Community. Must provide and document the completion of a comprehensive orientation and intake. A high school diploma or GED is required plus successful completion of the aftercare component of the corrections program is preferred. Must communicate effectively, verbally, and in writing. Must have a valid Florida driver's license with a good driving record. Computer competency is required and the ability to interact with people from diverse cultural, economic and ethnic backgrounds.
